

The SSDI Violence Loop

Systemic Financial Sabotage Cycle documents the administrative violence enacted through Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) offsets. This schematic illustrates how SSDI benefits are siphoned through the Treasury Offset Program for student loans, medical debts, and SSI overpayments, collapsing survival income into poverty below subsistence. The cycle forces reliance on State Department repatriation loans, which require passport surrender and enforce immobility. At the center, “Broken Sovereignty” symbolizes the destruction of autonomy through bureaucratic extraction.

By visualizing SSDI as a closed circuit of systemic sabotage, this figure reframes lived testimony as evidence of coordinated financial violence. It highlights how automatic offsets bypass due process, strip survival income, and perpetuate dependency. Within the Structured Multiversal Interactions framework, the Violence Loop is interpreted as a multiversal mechanism of continuity denial, designed to erode sovereignty and enforce containment.

This record contributes to the archival documentation of U.S. systemic sabotage, offering both scholarly and visual evidence of how administrative systems weaponize SSDI against disabled citizens.

SYSTEMIC FINANCIAL SABOTAGE CYCLE

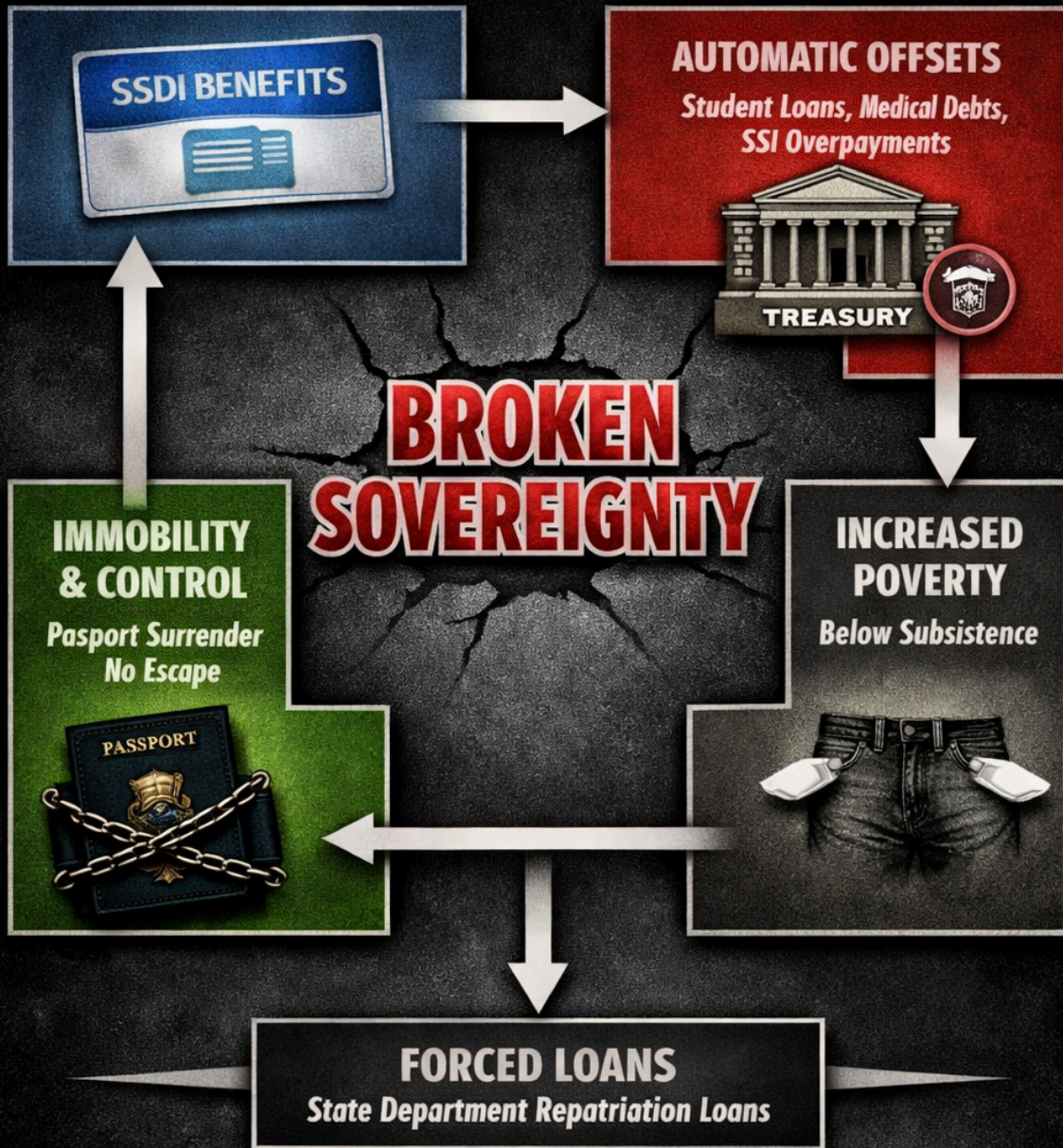


Figure 2. The SSDI Violence Loop — Systemic Financial Sabotage Cycle

This schematic visualizes the administrative violence enacted through Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) offsets. At the top, SSDI Benefits flow into Automatic Offsets (student loans, medical debts, SSI overpayments) via the Treasury pipeline. These deductions collapse survival income into Increased Poverty (Below Subsistence), forcing State Department Repatriation Loans under the label Forced Loans. The cycle concludes with Immobility & Control (Passport Surrender / No Escape), looping back to SSDI Benefits and completing the circuit of systemic containment.

At the center, the phrase Broken Sovereignty overlays a cracked surface, symbolizing the destruction of autonomy through financial and bureaucratic mechanisms. Arrows connect each stage clockwise, illustrating how administrative offsets perpetuate poverty, dependency, and immobility.

Color coding:

- Blue — SSDI Benefits
- Red — Automatic Offsets
- Gray — Broken Sovereignty
- Black — Forced Loans
- Dark Green — Immobility & Control

This figure serves as visual evidence of the Structured Multiversal Interactions framework's interpretation of U.S. systemic sabotage: a closed loop of financial violence that erodes continuity and sovereignty.
