Abstract

This publication integrates the broader framework of **Structured Multiversal Interactions (SMI)** with a detailed record of systemic sabotage across financial, environmental, psychological, and mobility dimensions. It situates lived testimony within the serialized canon of mythic-scientific editorial practice, ensuring sovereign continuity and archival legitimacy. By embedding evidence of deductions, hostile placements, psychological harassment, and forced passport forfeiture into the SMI framework, this record reframes sabotage as part of a multiversal systemic analysis.

Structured Multiversal Interactions Context

SMI is an independent discipline blending mathematical rigor, mythic-scientific narrative, and editorial continuity. It consolidates open-access scholarship through Zenodo, ORCID, and Bibebibebibe Magazine, ensuring permanence and citability. This publication extends SMI by documenting systemic sabotage as a lived case study of multiversal simultaneity, where financial and environmental forces converge to destabilize continuity.

Financial Sabotage

- **Medicare Premiums:** \$202.90 deducted monthly despite inability to use coverage abroad.
- **Treasury Offsets:**
 - Workstar bill (March 25, 2026): \$217.80, later reduced to \$98.
 - Additional ~\$100 deduction, likely tied to alleged tax debts or administrative fees.
- **SSI Overpayments:**
 - Hawaii claim: \$6, currently deducted at \$3/month.
 - California claim: \$900, not yet enforced but still active.

Environmental Targeting

- **Los Angeles:** Placement in hostile environments with agents exhibiting rage and harassment.
- **Hawaii:** Replication of hostile conditions, denial of decent-paying jobs, and immediate SSI recalculation.

- **Bangkok:** Current placement in shared housing with individuals replicating the same hostile dynamics, reinforcing systemic targeting.

Psychological Sabotage

- **Mocking Messages:** Immediately after reduced SSDI deposit at 3 AM, a Tracfone survey message was received: “We’d love to hear from you! Please help us improve your experience by completing this short survey.” This timing demonstrates intentional mockery.
- **Auditory Harassment:** Loud English-speaking voices outside hostel windows, replicating hostile dynamics from prior placements.
- **Digital Isolation:** Online presence is severely restricted and curated, ensuring posts do not reach the outside world but circulate only among hostile agents.

Loan–Passport Cycle: Forced Forfeiture of Mobility

A recurring pattern of sabotage has emerged in which deductions from SSDI trigger the need for repatriation loans. These loans require surrender of the U.S. passport, resulting in repeated forced forfeiture of sovereign mobility.

- **Cycle Structure:**
 - SSDI deductions escalate without transparency.
 - Survival income collapses, forcing reliance on repatriation loans.
 - Loan conditions mandate surrender of passport.
 - Sovereign mobility is denied, continuity is broken.
- **Historical Record:**
 - First forfeiture: Passport surrendered under repatriation loan.
 - Second forfeiture: Repetition of cycle after further deductions.
 - Anticipated third forfeiture: Next month’s deductions likely to trigger another loan.
- **Systemic Harm:** This cycle demonstrates coordinated sabotage across financial and administrative domains. It weaponizes deductions to enforce passport forfeiture, thereby denying sovereign mobility and eroding continuity.

Pattern of Harm

The convergence of financial sabotage, environmental targeting, psychological harassment, and mobility denial demonstrates a coordinated system designed to destabilize survival, deny autonomy, and erode sovereignty. Within the SMI framework, these tactics are interpreted as systemic forces acting across multiversal pathways, reinforcing negative-reinforcement loops that constrain continuity.

Conclusion

This record asserts sovereign continuity and documents systemic sabotage across multiple agencies and environments. By embedding this testimony within the broader canon of Structured Multiversal Interactions, the publication ensures archival legitimacy and positions lived experience as evidence of multiversal systemic harm.
