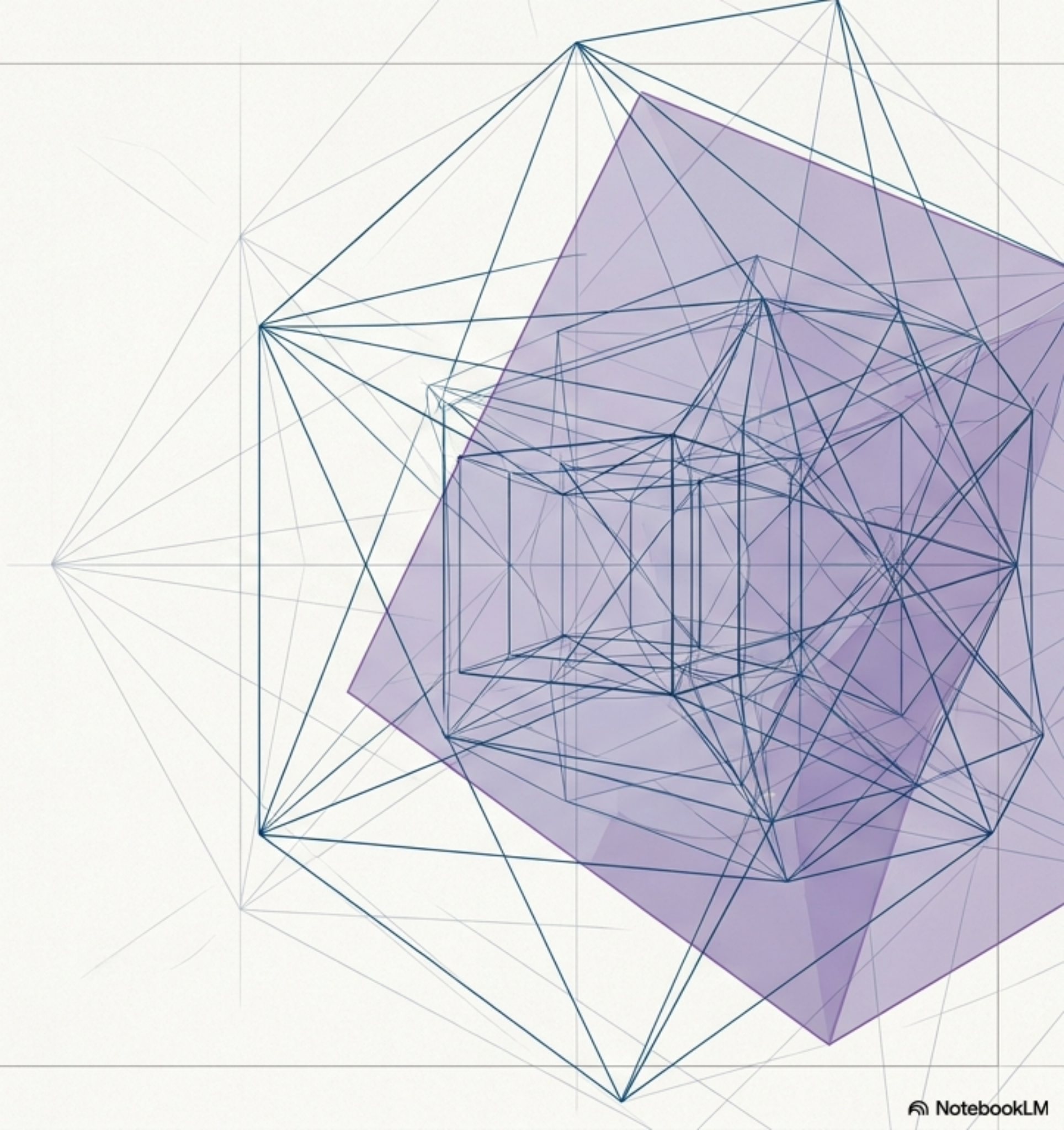

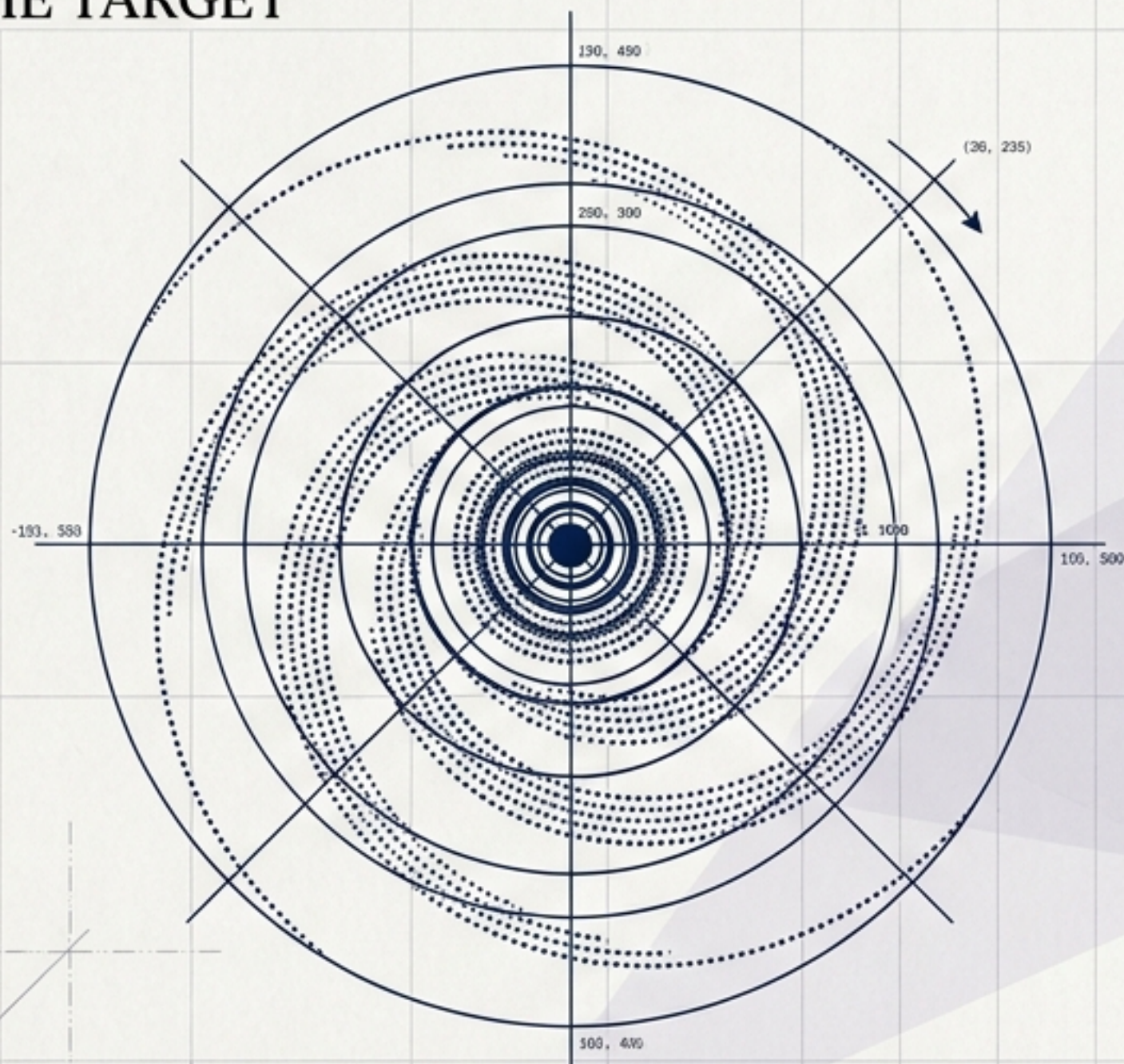

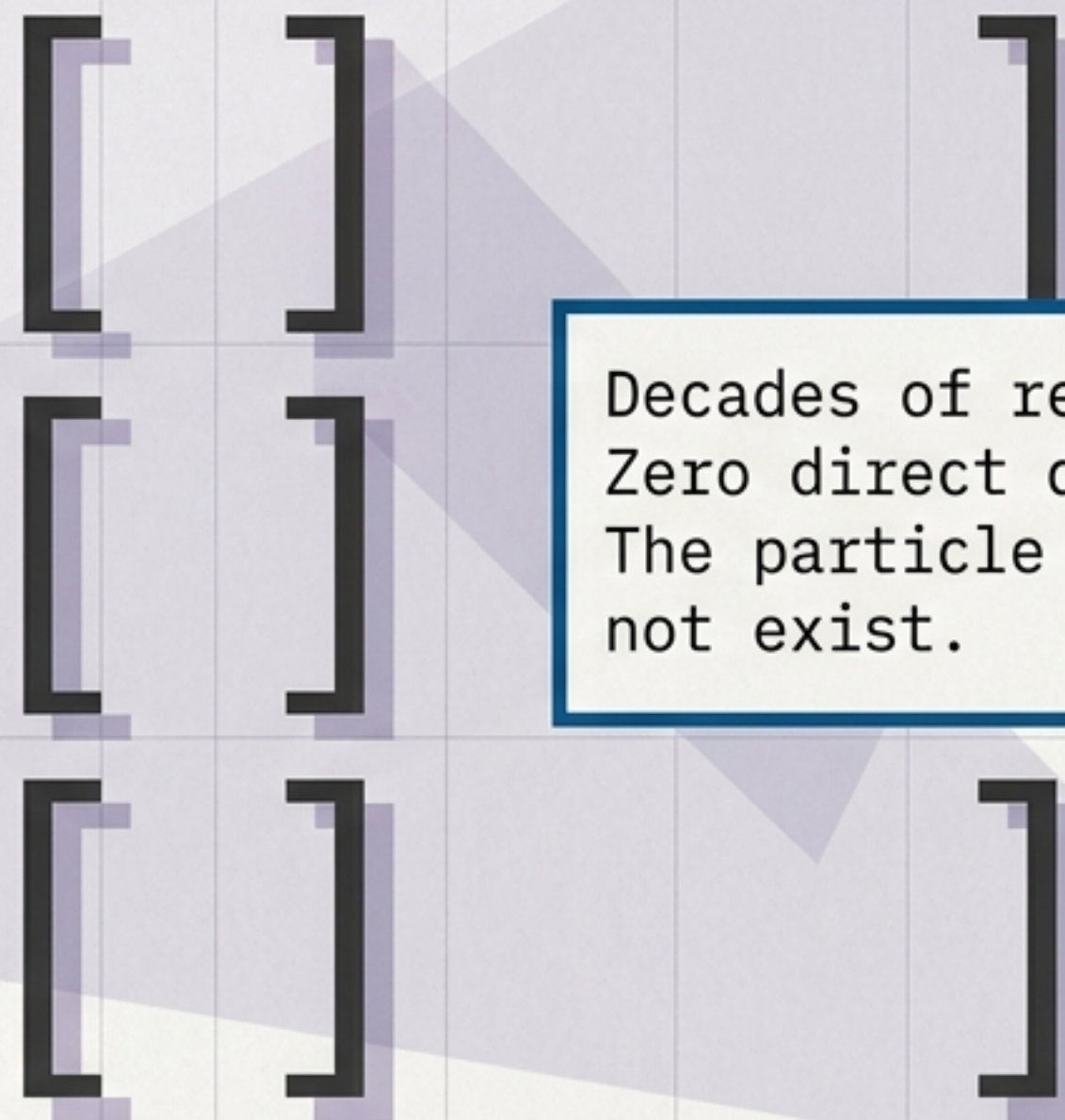
The Failure of the Missing Mass Paradigm

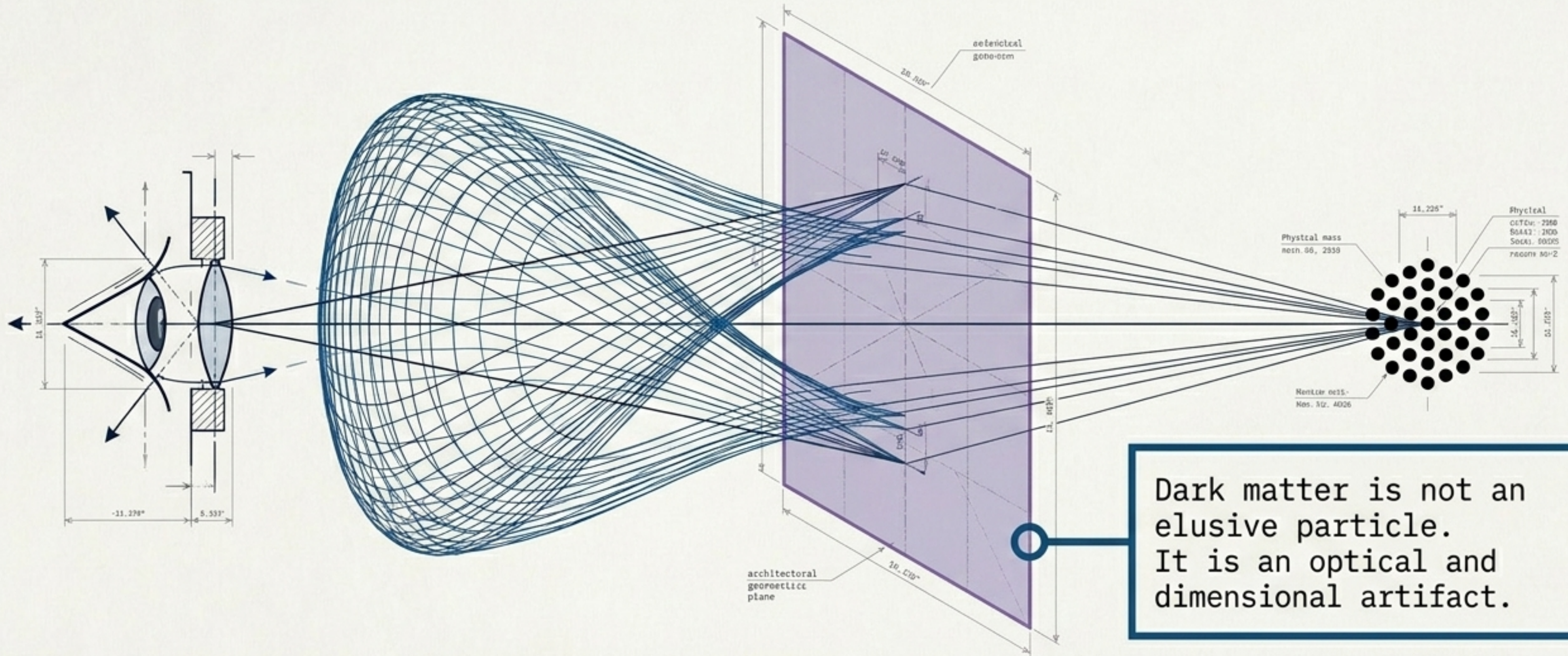

The Mass Was Never Missing. It Was Misrecognized.

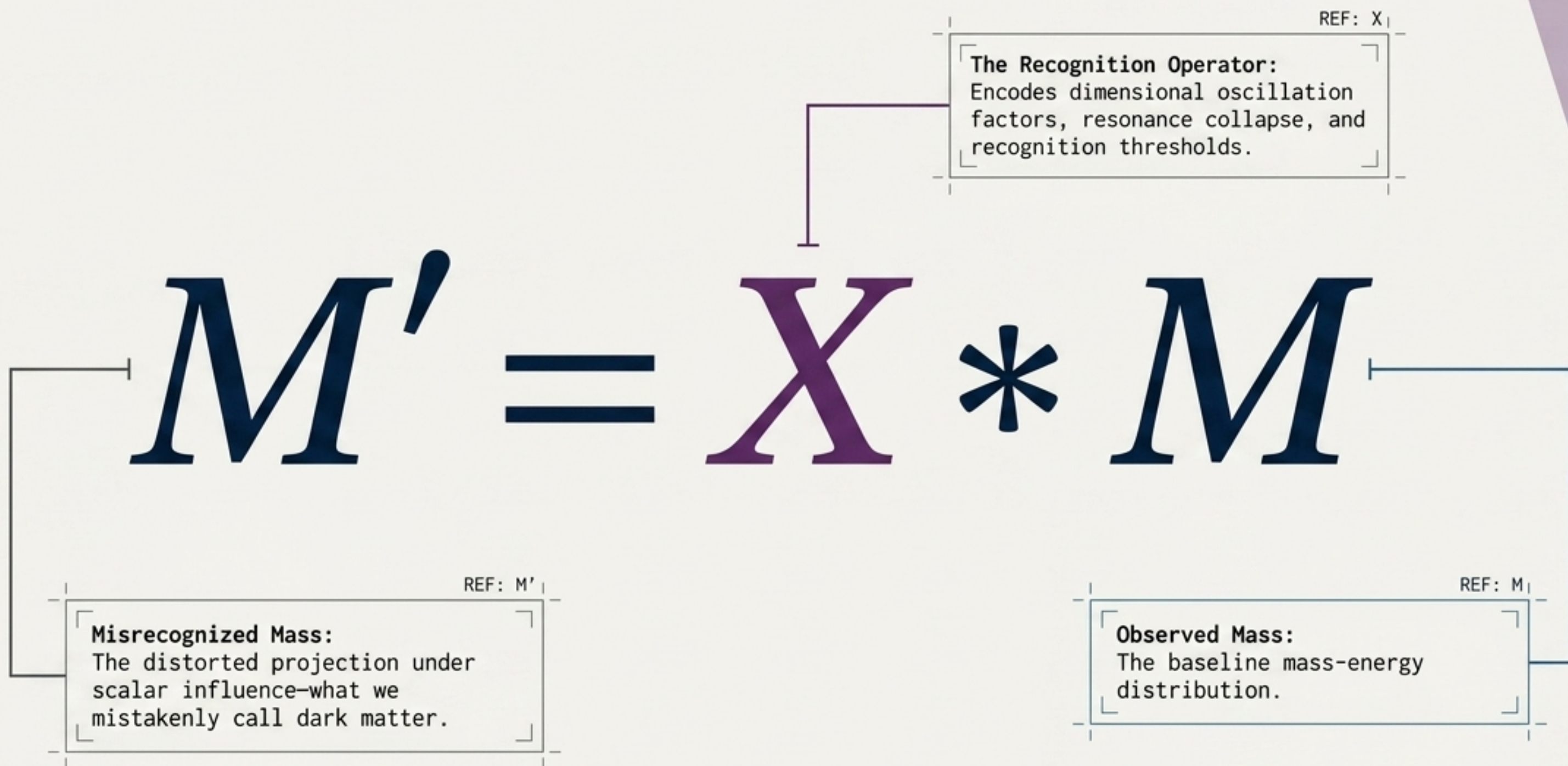


The anomaly arises from scalar distortions across reality levels. These distortions alter how mass-energy is perceived and calculated within our specific dimensional frame.

Cosmological Frameworks Comparison

Dimension	Conventional Cosmology	Scalar X (SMI Framework)
Core Assumption	Absent Particle Mass ➔	Dimensional Misrecognition
Cause of Anomalies	Undetected gravitational pull from dark matter ➔	Scalar distortions across reality levels
Mathematical Focus	Searching for a new mass variable ➔	Formalizing a dimensional recognition operator (X)

Formalizing Scalar X



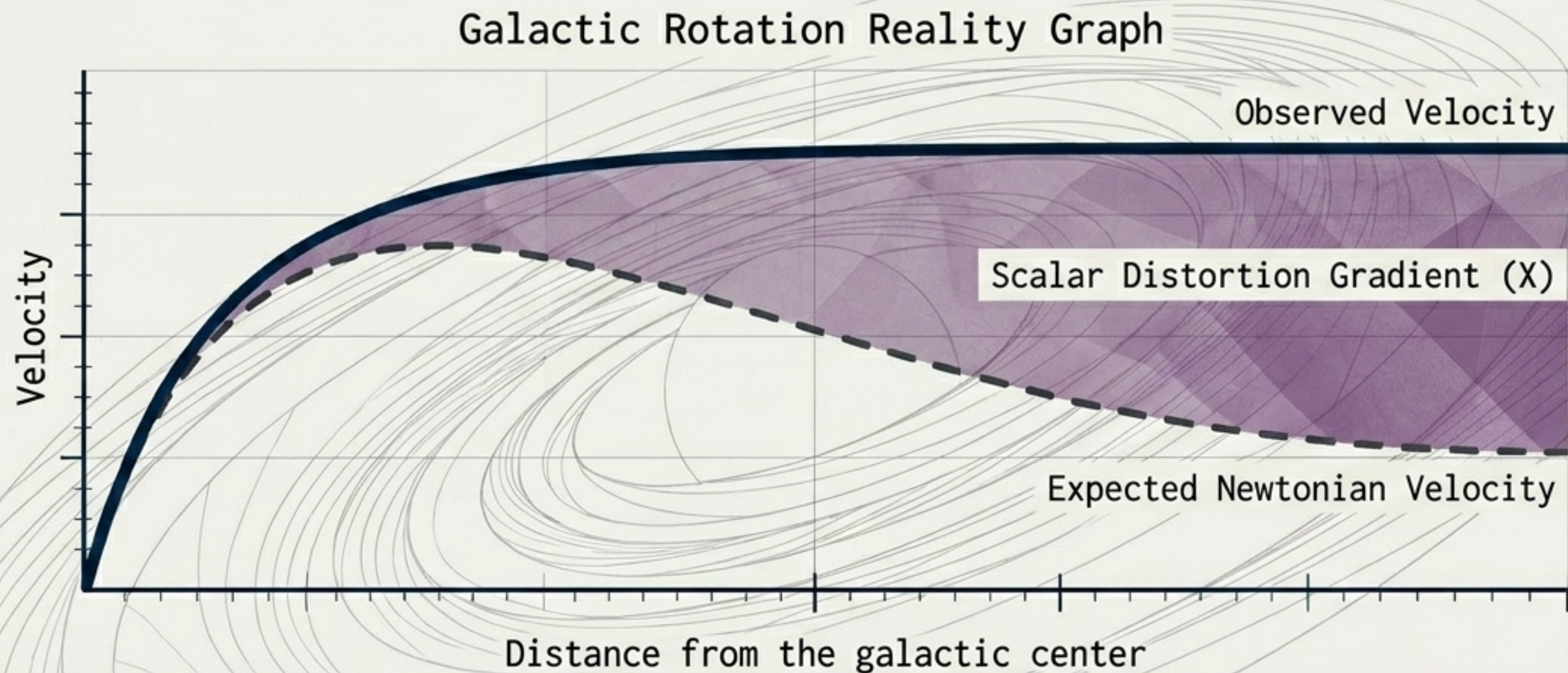
Translating Scalar X to Galactic Dynamics

When mapping galactic rotation,
 $M'(r)$ is not the true physical mass.
It is the scalar-distorted
recognition of mass.

$$v(r)^2 = \frac{G * M'(r)}{r}$$

The mathematical discrepancy between the true mass (M) and the misrecognized mass (M') produces the exact mathematical illusion of missing matter.

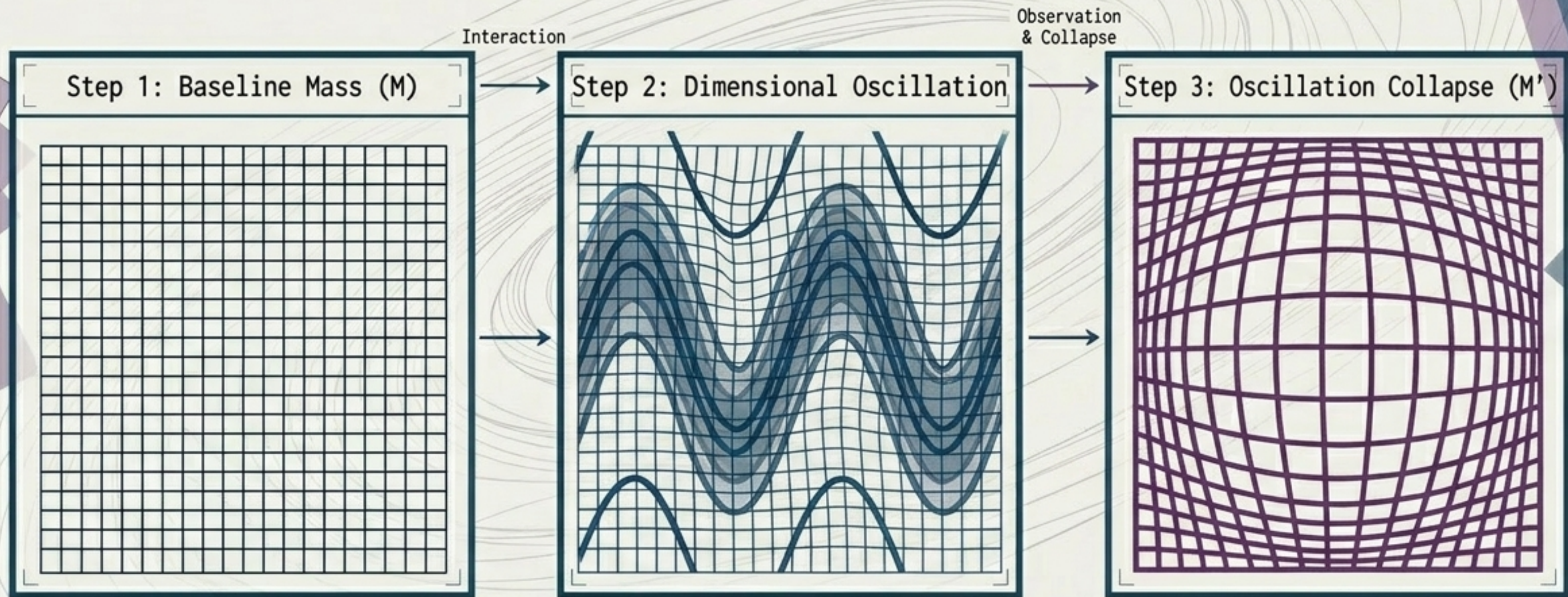
The Recognition Distortion Overlay



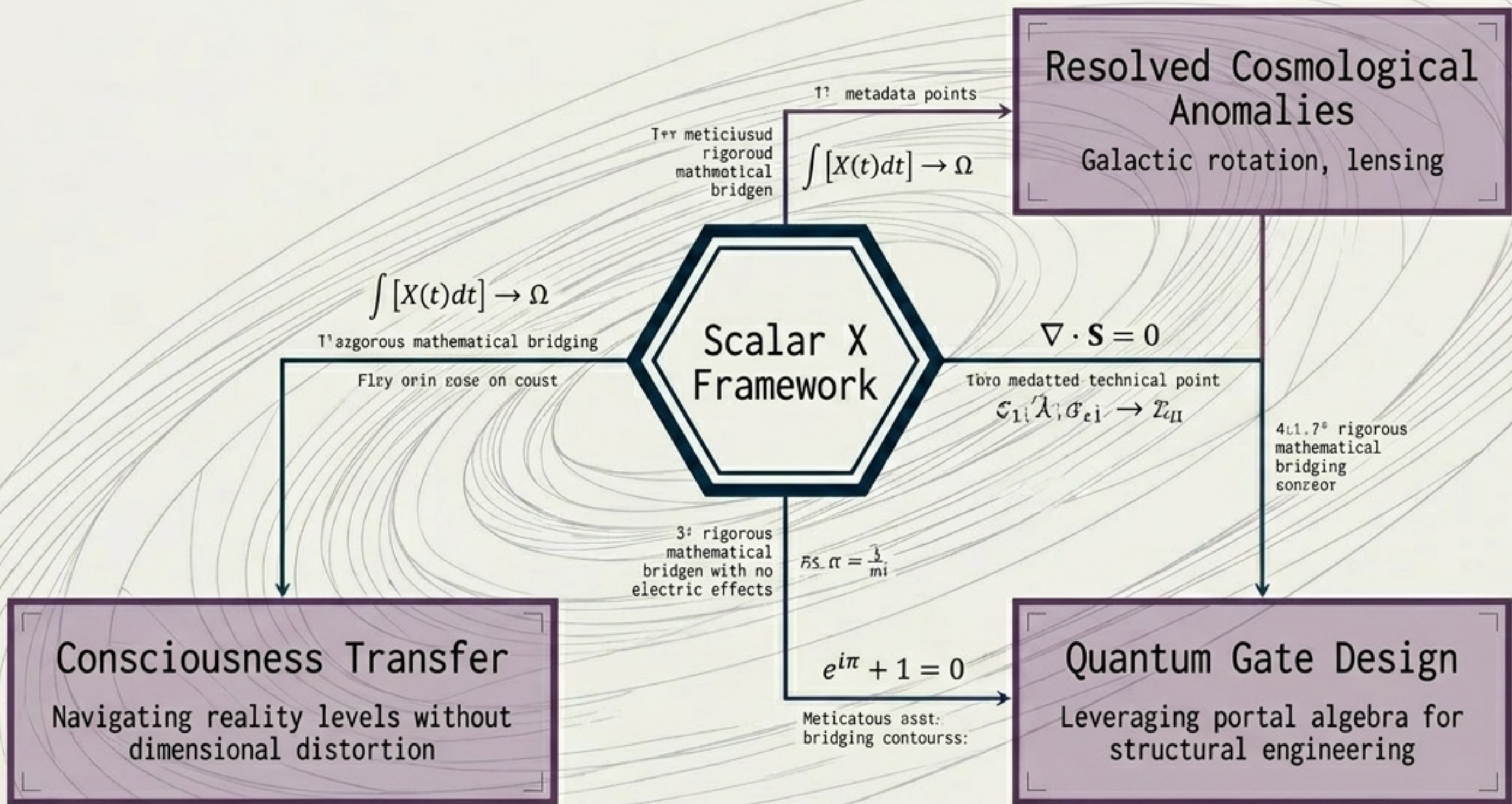
No invisible particles are required. The operator X perfectly accounts for the mathematical gap between expected and observed rotational velocities.

The Mechanics of Oscillation Collapse
