

Systemic Sabotage: Financial, Environmental, and Psychological Targeting

Abstract

This publication documents coordinated government sabotage across financial, environmental, and psychological dimensions. It provides evidence of deductions from Social Security benefits, hostile placements across geographies, and psychological harassment designed to destabilize survival and sovereignty. The record is intended for archival continuity and scholarly reference.

Financial Sabotage

Medicare Premiums: \$202.90 deducted monthly despite inability to use coverage abroad.

Treasury Offsets:

Workstar bill (March 25, 2026): \$217.80, later reduced to \$98.

Additional ~\$100 deduction, likely tied to alleged tax debts or administrative fees.

SSI Overpayments:

Hawaii claim: \$6, currently deducted at \$3/month.

California claim: \$900, not yet enforced but still active.

Environmental Targeting

Los Angeles: Placement in hostile environments with agents exhibiting rage and harassment.

Hawaii: Replication of hostile conditions, denial of decent-paying jobs, and immediate SSI recalculation.

Bangkok: Current placement in shared housing with individuals replicating the same hostile dynamics, reinforcing systemic targeting.

Psychological Sabotage

Mocking Messages: Immediately after reduced SSDI deposit at 3 AM, a Tracfone survey message was received: "We'd love to hear from you! Please help us improve your experience by completing this short survey." This timing demonstrates intentional mockery.

Auditory Harassment: Loud English-speaking voices outside hostel windows, replicating hostile dynamics from prior placements.

Digital Isolation: Online presence is severely restricted and curated, ensuring posts do not reach the outside world but circulate only among hostile agents.

Pattern of Harm

The convergence of financial sabotage, environmental targeting, and psychological harassment demonstrates a coordinated system designed to destabilize survival, deny autonomy, and erode sovereignty. Deductions activate at moments of vulnerability, while hostile placements and mocking signals replicate across geographies.

Conclusion

This record asserts sovereign continuity and documents systemic sabotage across multiple agencies and environments. It is intended for publication on Zenodo to establish archival legitimacy and provide a citable reference for systemic harm.
