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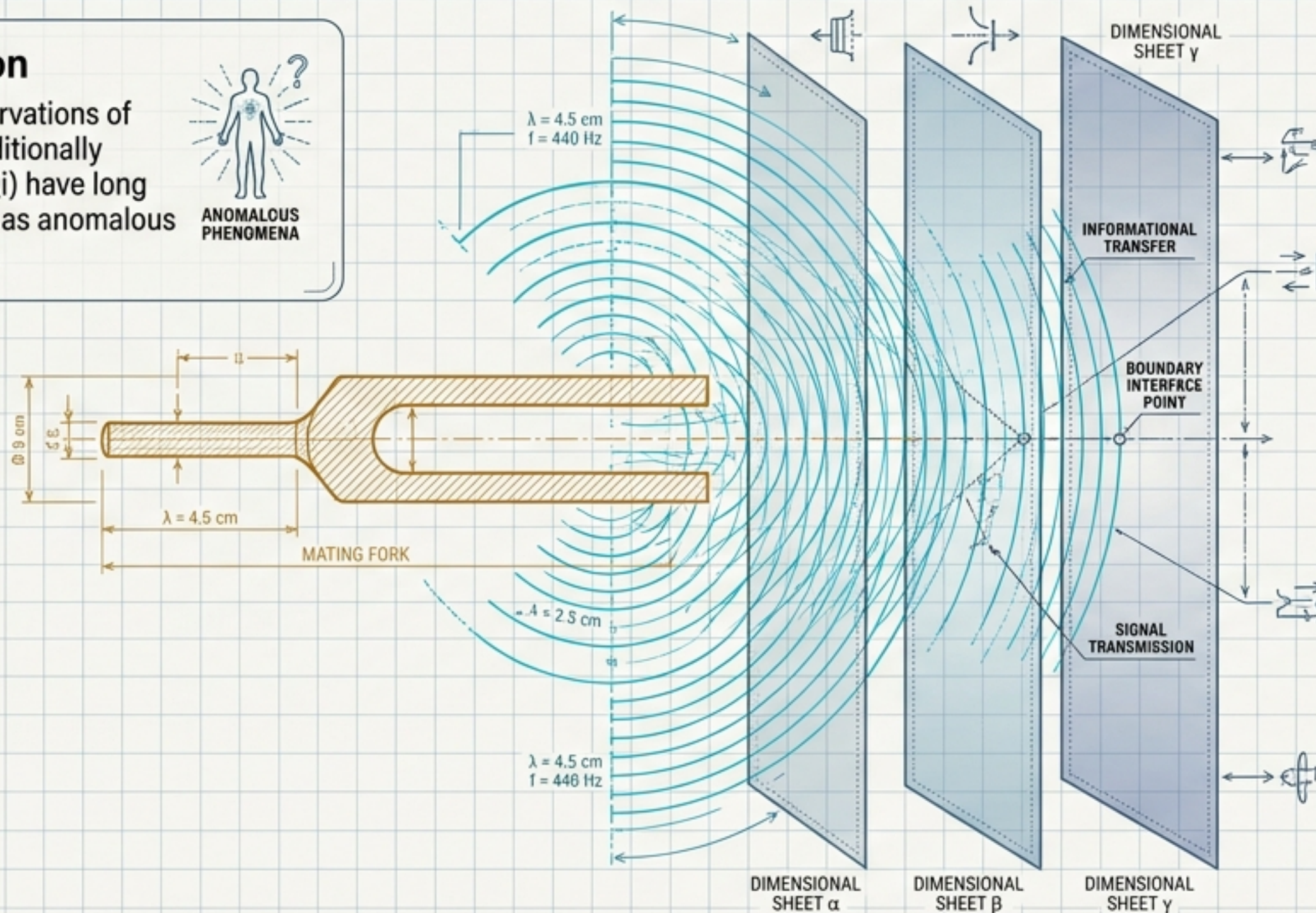
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Traditional bio-energetic fields are precise, cross-boundary informational interfaces.

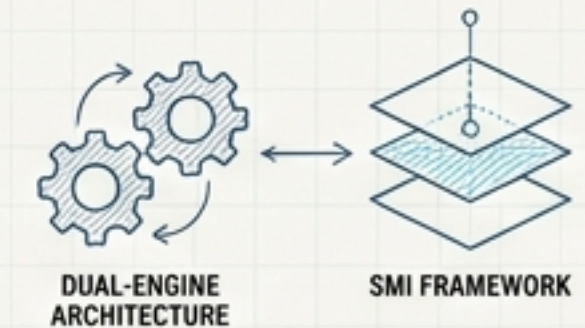
The Observation

Historic cultural observations of localized energy (traditionally designated as Ki or Qi) have long been miscategorized as anomalous spiritual phenomena.



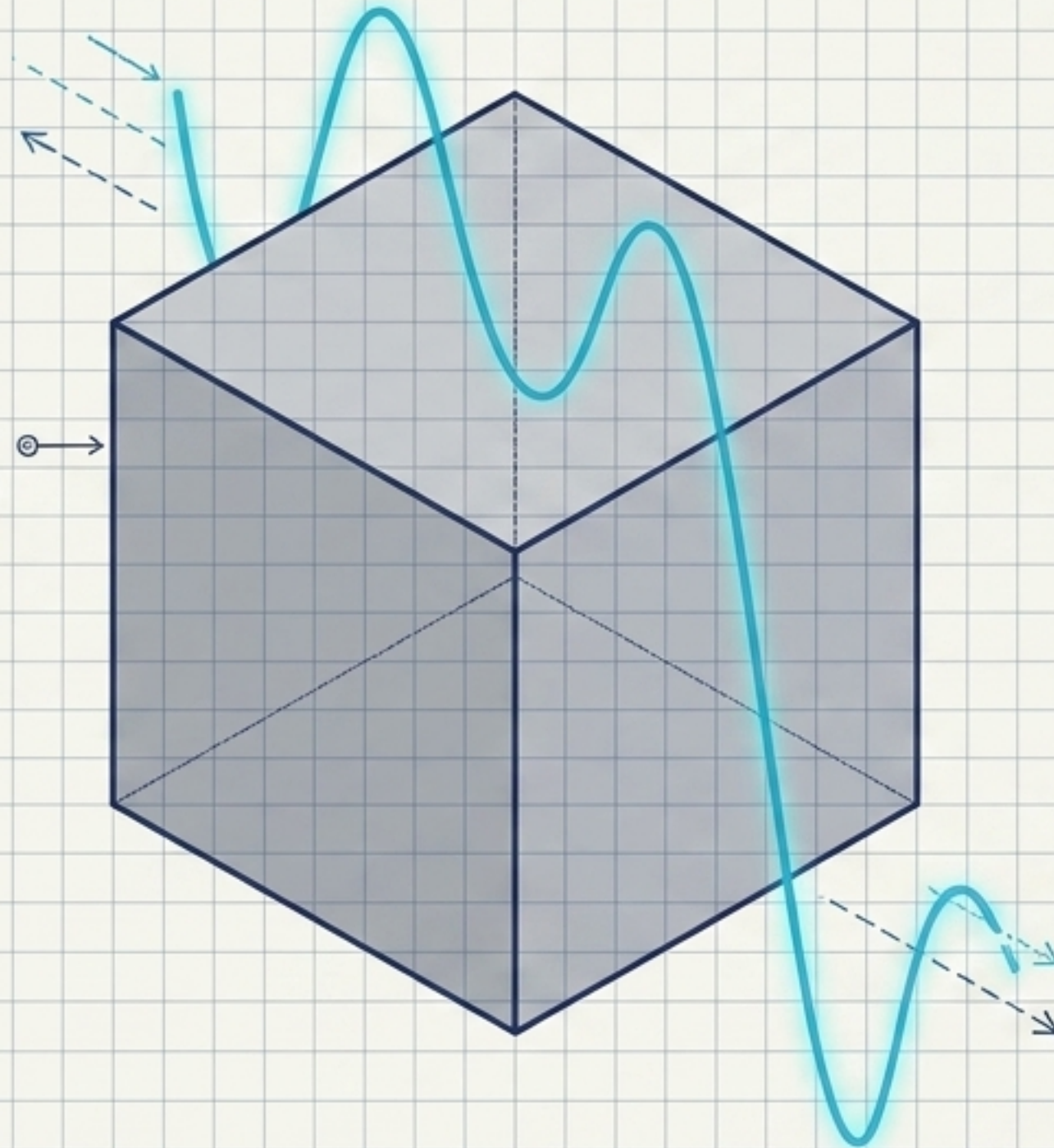
The Reality

Experimental Apparatus

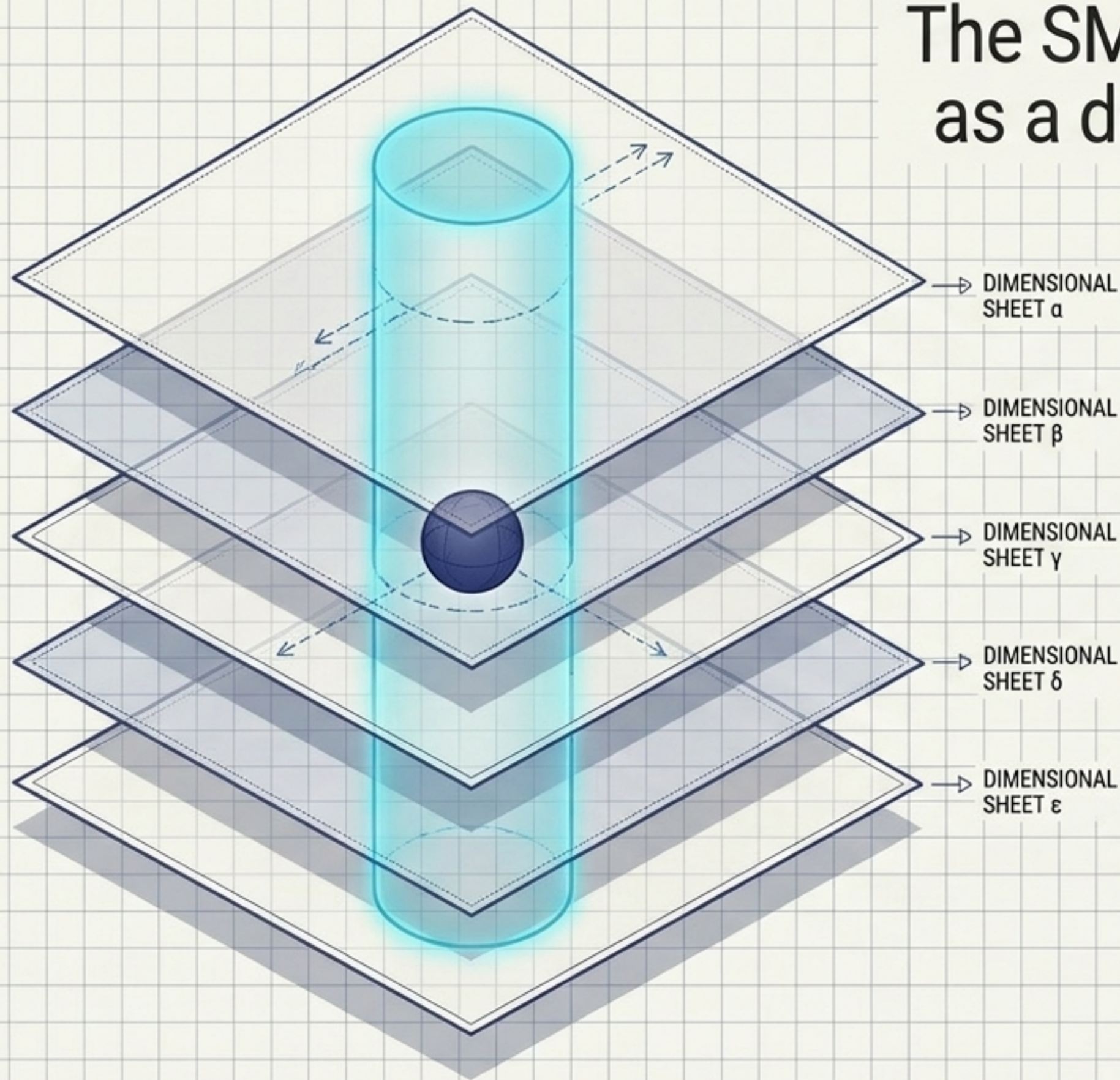

Reality is not an isolated, flat continuum. It is a vertical stack of dimensional sheets.

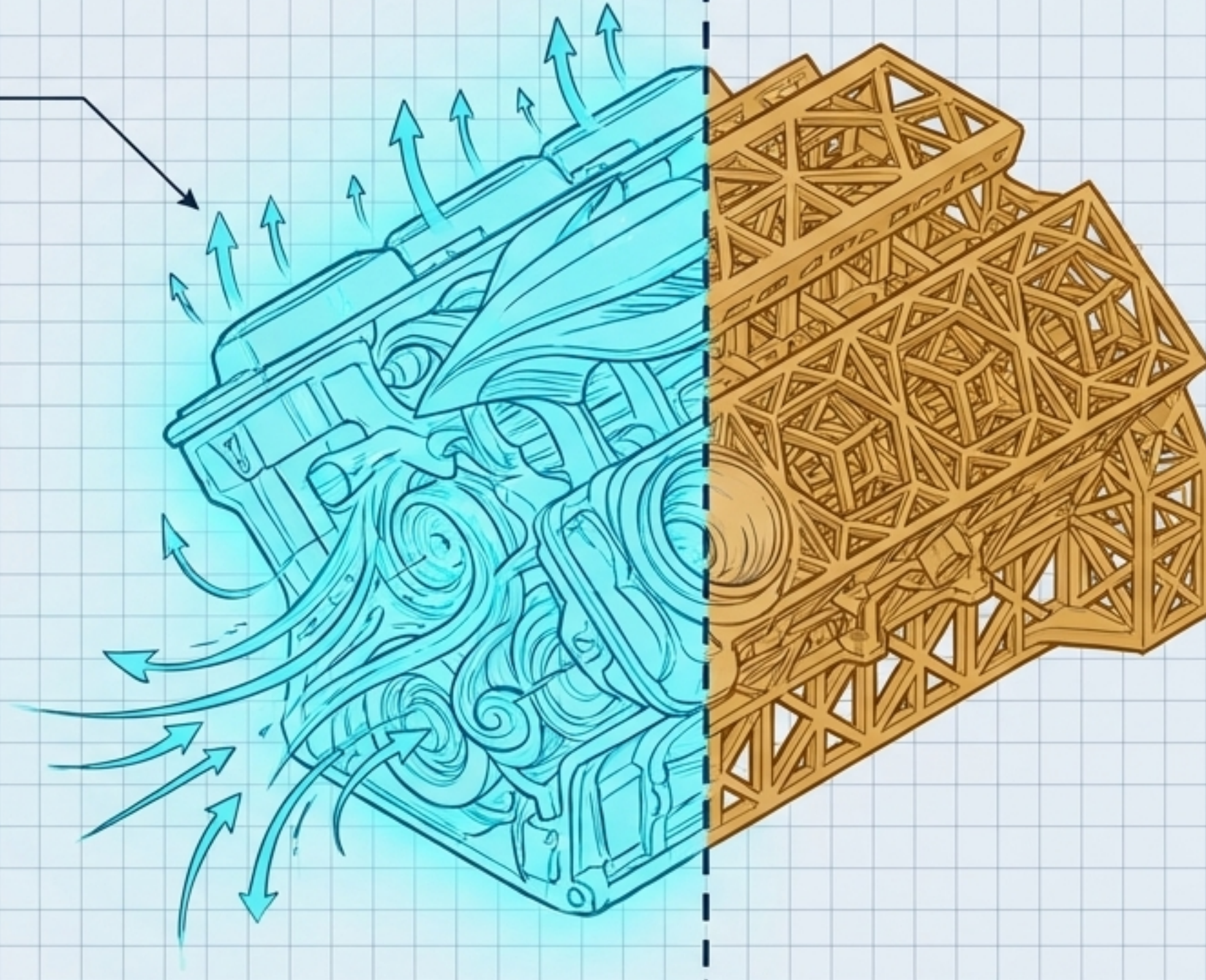
- **The Conscious Node**

Propulsion Vector

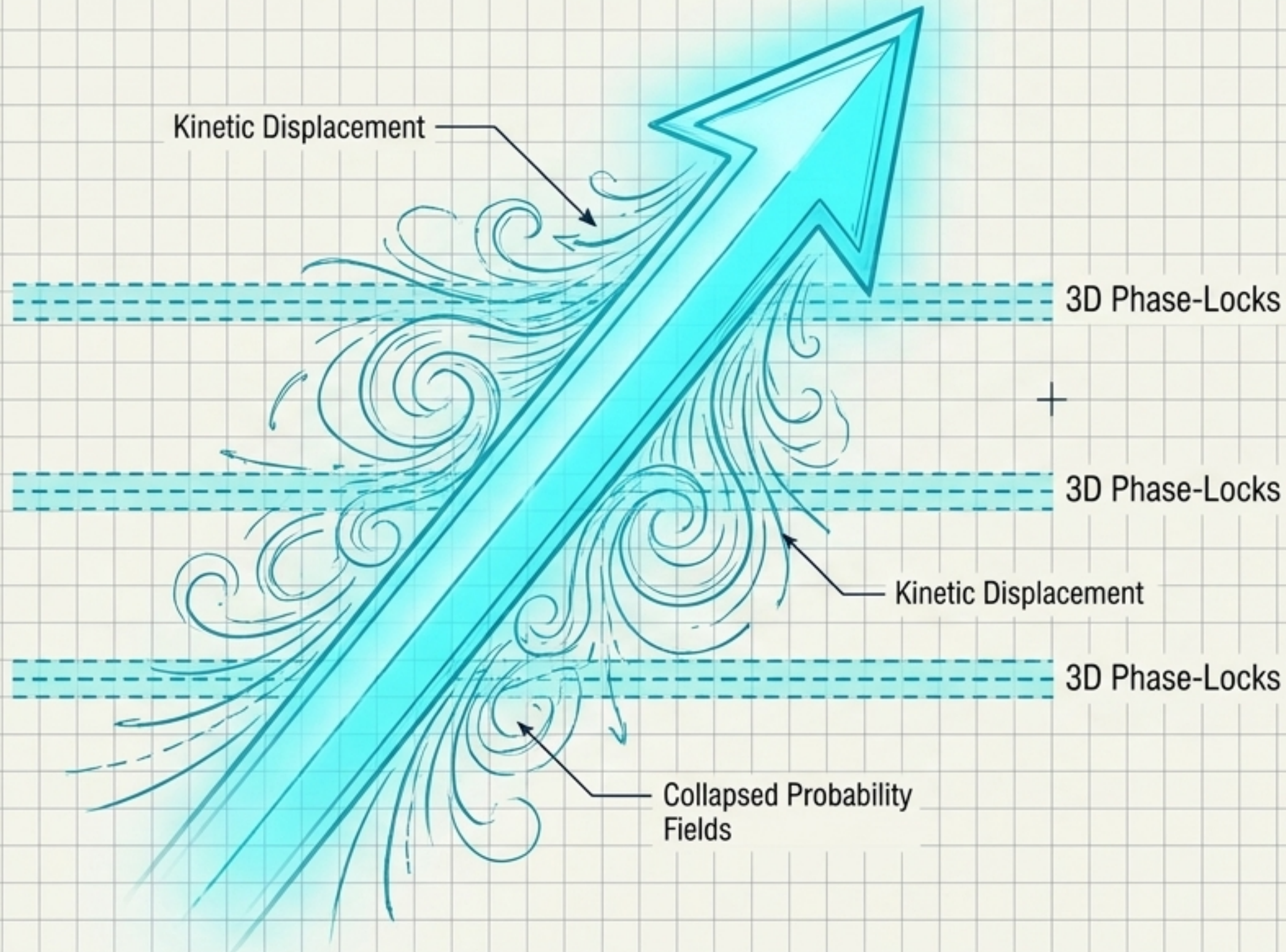
The kinetic force required to achieve variable timeline permeability and move through the reality stack.

Functional Definition

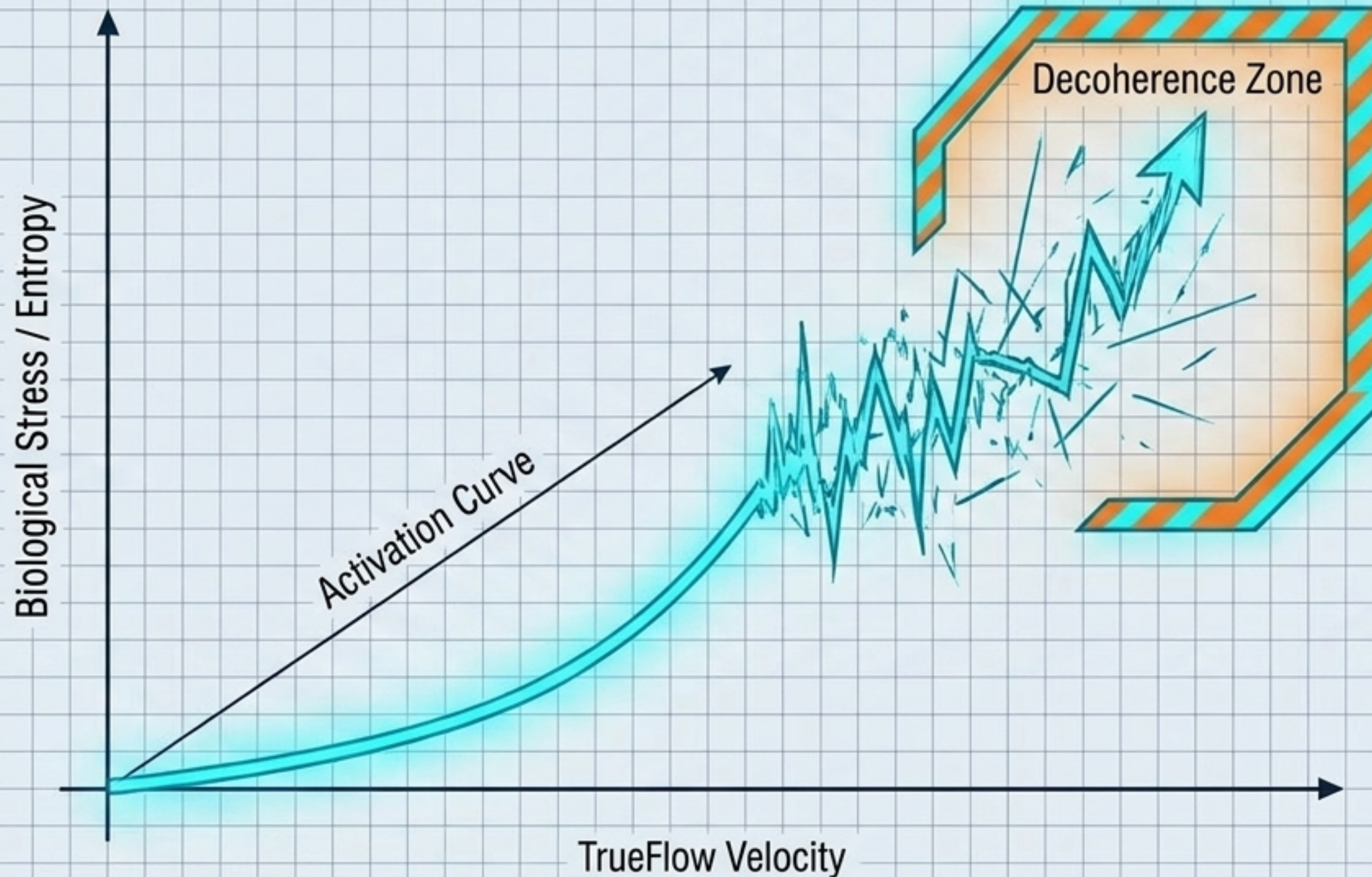
TrueFlow represents the localized velocity of consciousness navigating through adjacent state-spaces.

High-velocity TrueFlow currents without stabilization introduce severe systemic entropy.



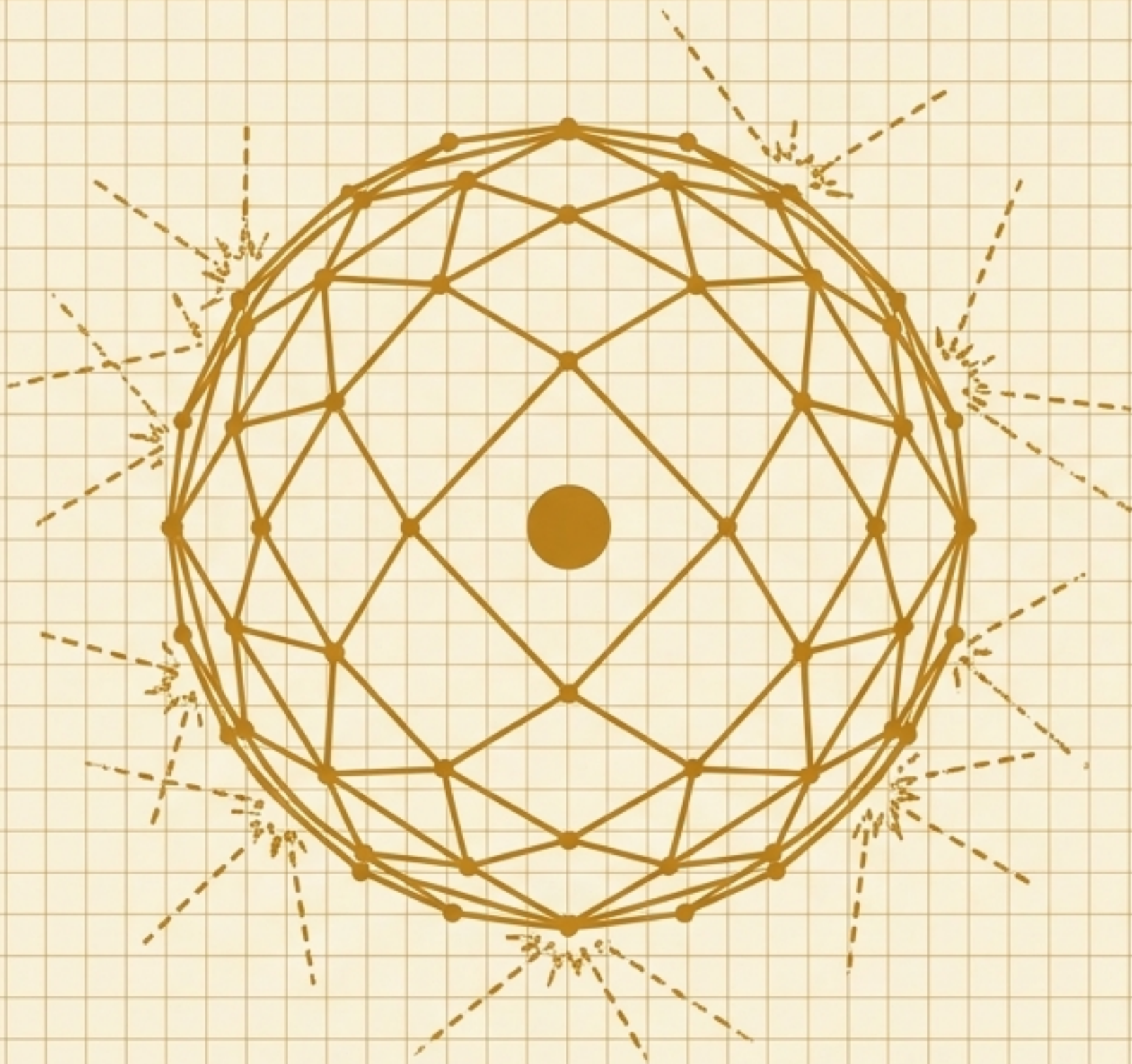
The Threat

The resulting phenomenon when an individual conscious node transitions from a passive observer to an active architecture module.

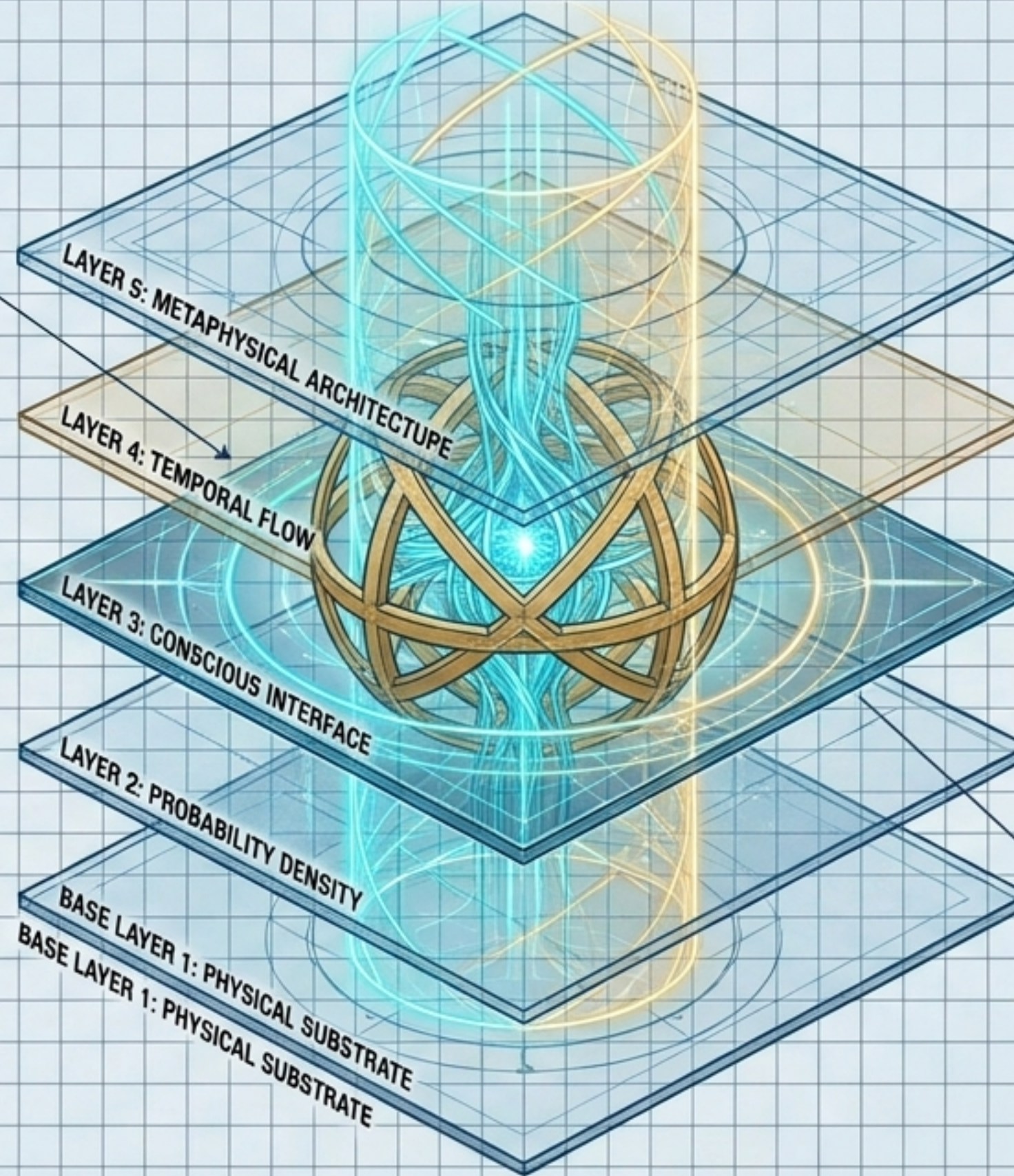
Translating historic somatic intuition into SMI operational mechanics.

Sovereign Diagnostics & Reality Pathfinding

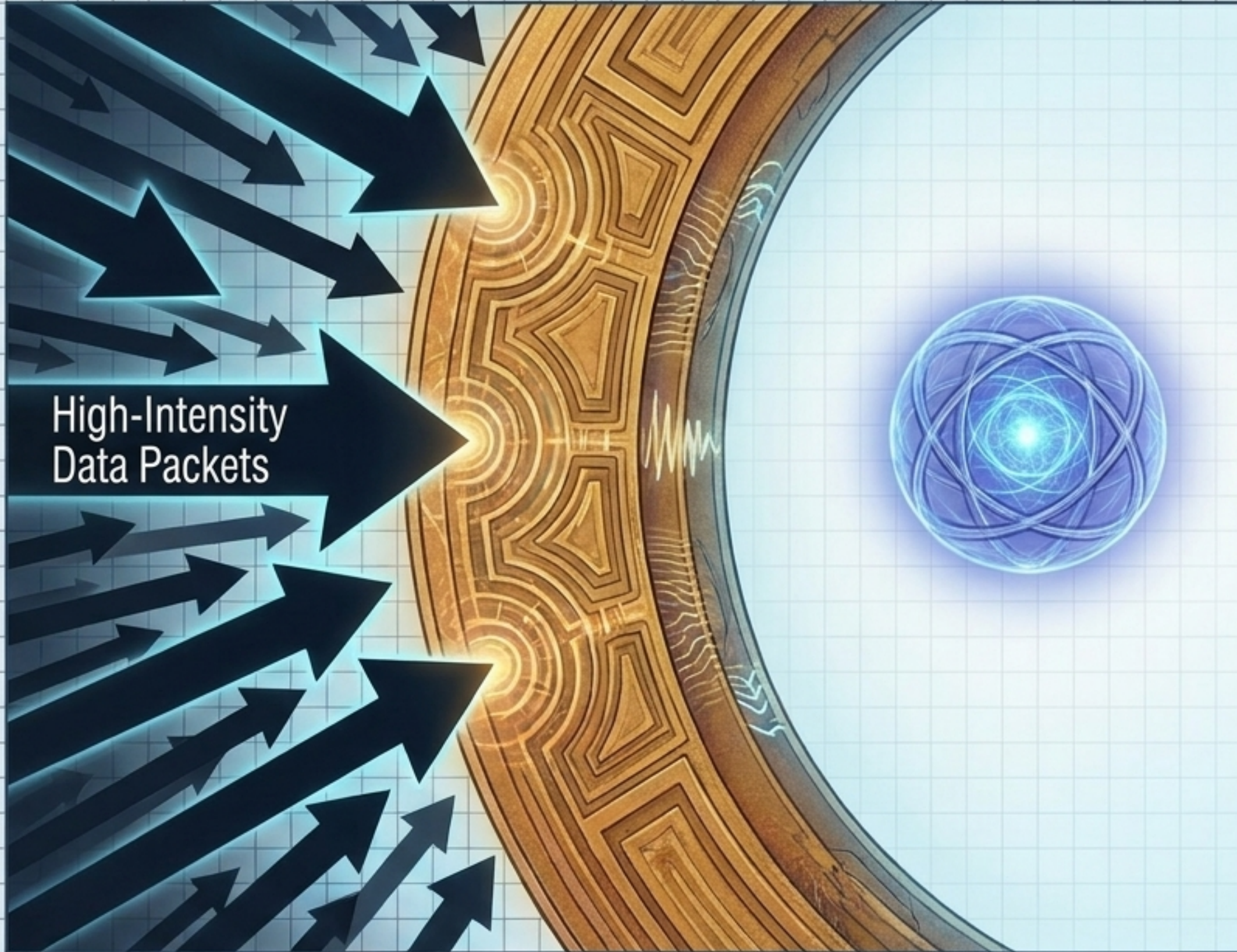
When individual conscious synthesis is achieved, the user is no longer locked into a single 3D phase-space.

Internal Resonance Isolation allows high-intensity data absorption without structural damage.

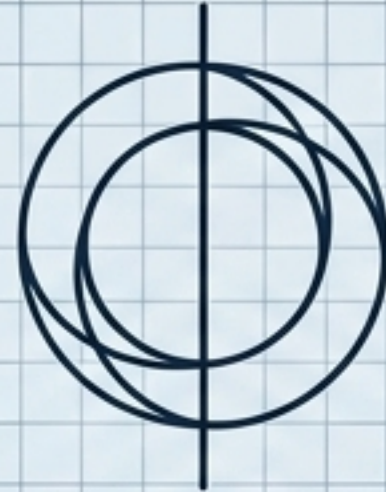


The Somatic Guarantee
